## **Information Collection and Usage:**

Our registration forms collect users' contact details, such as their name, email address, format preference (HTML vs. Text), address, interests, and other relevant information. It's crucial to mention that we do not request or store sensitive data like credit card or social security numbers from our website visitors.

## **Internet Protocol Address:**

ACC's site gather the IP addresses of all visitors. An IP address is a unique number assigned to your computer when you connect to the Internet. These addresses assist us in diagnosing server issues, managing the Site, studying trends, monitoring user activity, collecting general demographic data for overall enhancement of the site, and providing tailored content. Importantly, IP addresses are not connected to personally identifiable information.

## **Use of "Cookies":**

Cookies may be utilized on our Site to improve your browsing experience. These are data pieces that certain websites transfer to visitors' computers for record-keeping purposes. Cookies assist in making web navigation smoother by storing passwords and personal preferences. They also help in preventing repetitive ad displays.
